- 1998 – Initial FP Facility opened with two lines
- 2000 – 2004 – Three additional lines added to original Facility
- 2005 – \$55 million construction on phase one of second FP Facility which began operation in November 2005
- 2008 – Completed expansions and began operations in February of 2008 at second FP Facility
- 2008 – Opened Decatur Cold Storage (DCS) Freezer Facility on Site
- 2010 – Completed addition of the DSI and IPM portioning lines and began operations in August
- 2013 – Completed state of the art Parfry/IF line and Raw Marinated line
- 2014 – Doubled portioning capabilities
- 2014 – Start up high-capacity cook-in-pouch line August 5th
